Each division has appointed a Senior Manager as the Management Representative with responsibility and authority for all matters pertaining to the system elements.

Each division has appointed a Competent person who will provide support, guidance and training in matters relating to OH&S and who is focused on ensuring in conjunction with the organisations management the integrity of the Management System.

The managers are responsible for health & safety within the organisation.

The organisation is responsible for provide adequate and appropriate resources, competency, awareness & training to implement the policy.

The Management System will be periodically audited to maintain compliance with relevant International Standards.
